

Family of David PATCH and Ann BAGG

This chart is a synopsis of the lives of David and Ann Patch's family:

- children- 9 (listed in blue)
- spouses of children- 8 (listed in green)
- grandchildren- 28 (We're confident that this is a complete list. Two of David and Ann's children (William and Elizabeth Mary) had no children.)
- spouses of grandchildren- only 1 before 1901 (listed in purple)
- great-grandchildren- only 1 before 1901 (listed in purple)

Darkened boxes indicate that the person was not living at the time of that particular census. Yellow-filled boxes indicate that the person was married at that time. Each box includes the person's age, occupation and domicile at the time of the census. Where an individual's name, as recorded in a particular census, differed from his or her first name, the alternate name has been included in quotes. In a few cases (6), I have been unable to locate a person in the census records. These boxes have been left empty.

In addition to the person's name, the first column includes his or her birth, marriage and death dates and places. Dates and places that are shown in parentheses are approximations.

Unless otherwise indicated, locations listed are in Somerset, England.
