Temple records (Manti- film # 170439) indicate birth was in 1794.

13 October 2000:
 There is some confusion as to the correct identification of Sarah Monk. William Monk and Sarah Ann Bear(e) were married 25 Jan 1821 in Hurstbourne Priors, Hamphsire. They lived in Longparish. According to the Longparish parish register, one child, Charles, was born, baptized and buried there. Another child, William Monk "of Andover," was buried in Longparish on 19 Nov 1822. It is unknown if this William was the child of William Monk and Sarah Ann Beare.

Three additional children, Jane, Charles, and Elizabeth, were baptized at this time in Longparish. Their parents were listed as William and Mary Monk. An additional child, Walter, was buried as an infant in 1830. He could also be a member of this family.

To all appearances, it would seem that Sarah Ann Beare died after the birth of Charles (1) and that William remarried a woman named Mary. However, the family is found in both the 1841 and 1851 censuses with the mother named Sarah.

Furthermore, Charles Monk, born 1832, referred to his mother as "Sarah" and as "Mary."

I am tentatively placing all the children in the same family with Sarah Ann Bear(e) as the mother. It seems to me that "Mary" was a nickname given to her in the parish registers, as it does not appear any other place. This needs further investigation.

4 November 2000:
 Linda Monk Dursteller, family member and professional genealogist, researched this family extensively in the 1970's and based on information available at the time, concluded that Sarah Monk must have died after bearing 2 children (William and Charles). William then remarried a woman named Mary, who bore him 4 children and died. William Monk, supposedly then remarried a third woman, also named Sarah, who appears with the family in the 1841 and 1851 censuses.

Family tradition says that Charles Monk referred to his mother as "Sarah" and as "Mary." He had the temple work done for Sarah Ann Bear(e), but not for anyone named Mary.

Charles was conscientious about doing temple work for family members and surely would have done the work for his mother- Sarah Ann Beare would have been his step-mother (and he never knew her because she would have been the first wife). This implies that Sarah and Mary were the same person and that William Monk was married only once.

More research into this situation was suggested by Linda Monk Dursteller. In October and November, 2000, Wendie C. Monk Whitehead, Carol A. Monk Moore and Norma K. Belmont Monk searched the civil registration index for additional clues. They found that there is no listing for a Sarah Monk dying in either the Andover or Whitchurch registration districts between 1837 and 1880. There is one listing for a Mary Monk, but she is identified as the two-year old daughter of George and Maria Monk of Wherwell, Hampshire. (George is William's brother.) Furthermore, no marriage for William and Mary or William and the second Sarah was found. However, this is not proof positive because civil registration in England began in 1837 and some or all of these events could have occurred before that date. The Longparish parish registers and bishop's transcripts do not show any of these alleged events either.

In September, 2000, I heard a report of another woman named Sarah Monk, living in Odiham, Hampshire, using the name "Mary" as a nickname. (This is not the same Sarah Monk; it is simply a coincidence that they were both named Monk.) Wendie inquired about this (Sarah & Mary) at the Family History Library in Salt Lake City and learned that the name Mary is used as a nickname for the name Sarah. We worried about being able to prove that Sarah Ann Bear(e) used the nickname "Mary" but were told by workers at the Family History Library in Salt Lake City that the absence of any death or marriage entries in the civil registration index and the parish records as well as the fact that Charles Monk did not indicate that his father had been married to more than one woman must be construed as evidence (not proof)

The next item to research is whether the other two children listed in the Longparish parish register (William and Walter) are William and Sarah's children.
